

HISTORY

The Ligonier Valley Historical Society was formed in 1964 by the Ligonier Women's Club. At that time, its primary purpose was the recording of oral histories and the maintenance of abandoned cemeteries in the Ligonier Valley.

In 1966, with the assistance of the R. K. Mellon Foundation, the society bought Compass Inn, then a private home, from Mrs. Virginia Swank. The house was restored and opened as a museum on May 27, 1972. The site has been expanded and now includes an authentically reconstructed cookhouse, barn, carpenter shop, and blacksmith shop.

LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR of OPERATIONS

Although Compass Inn may be closed during the winter months, a great amount of work remains. The Museum is a large piece of the Ligonier Valley Historical Society puzzle; however, there are many other components that contribute to its success.

In the past year, under the leadership of the Program Committee, we have reinstated the exciting lecture series including:

- Bob Oshnock, an archaeologist from the Westmoreland Archaeology Society, who presented a program on *Prehistoric Indians, The Monongahela People*
- Dave Byers discussed Why the Ligonier Valley Railroad could not exist today, and
- A first person interpretation of Colonel James Pollock presented by Charles A. Fagan III.

The Historical Society ran several very successful fundraisers throughout the year to increase our funds for general operating support. The Tastes of the Town, the Fort Ligonier Days food booth, and the Festival of Lights are our three major fundraisers. Additionally, we sponsored two yard sales in the field behind Compass Inn Museum, sold raffle tickets for a private dinner that was served in the Common Room of the Museum, and promoted the annual Day of Giving through the Community Foundation of Westmoreland County in which the donor contributors increased by 68%.

This past year, we pursued opportunities to partner with other organizations and embraced the possibility for future endeavors. With the Ligonier Valley Chamber of Commerce and Valley Players of Ligonier, we promoted Christmas in Ligonier during the first two weekends of December, featuring the Festival of Lights. We teamed with Fort Ligonier, Antiochian Village, Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art, Ligonier Valley Rail Road Association, and the Valley Players of Ligonier for Community Day. We also partnered with The Lincoln Highway Heritage Corridor, who sponsored *Inside Ligonier, A Home Tour* with which several of our members assisted.

The standing committees of the Society contributed to the success of the year. The membership committee ran an active campaign and recruited several new members to join the Society. The Records and Documents team made progress in cataloging the artifacts in the archival computer program. The Buildings and Grounds chairman organized a clean-up day in the blacksmith shop when several of our volunteer blacksmiths assisted in reorganizing the shop to get it ready for the season. Brainstorming program ideas falls under the direction of the Museum, Research, and Acquisition committee. Finally, the Hospitality Committee organizes the refreshments for all of our events.

These are just a few of the committees and the work that they have accomplished during the year.

In conclusion, the Historical Society remains at a steady pace throughout the year as our tasks are many and there are always opportunities to grow, grants to write, and relationships to cultivate. We remain committed to pursuing the steady growth and preservation of the Society and Museum for current and future generations to enjoy.
